He has published more than 200 peer-reviewed articles in leading international journals and has authored numerous book chapters and edited several scholarly books in accounting, governance, sustainability, and Islamic finance.
- Professor Hussainey earned his Ph.D. in Accounting and Finance from The University of Manchester, United Kingdom, following a Master's degree from The University of Birmingham and a Bachelor's degree in Accounting from Ain Shams University, Egypt. Throughout his distinguished academic career, he has held faculty positions at Bangor University, Portsmouth University, Plymouth University, Stirling University, Manchester University, and Ain Shams University.
- His academic leadership extends to supervising more than 70 doctoral researchers, examining over 130 doctoral dissertations, securing major international research grants, and serving as Editor, Co-Editor, and Associate Editor of several internationally indexed journals. His work has significantly influenced global research in corporate reporting, governance, sustainability, financial disclosure, and accounting innovation.
